New benches for the Glebeland and Brookside Meadow

The Parish Council is delighted that an application to Hertsmere Borough Council for a grant under the Ward Initiative Scheme has been successful and as a result two new benches have been installed on the Glebeland and a further two along Bridlepath 76 through the Brookside Meadow. Councillors would like to thank Councillor Peter Wayne for his guidance and support during the application process.

Further proposed improvements to the Brookside Greenspace area, owned and managed by Hertsmere Borough Council, include planting of hedgerows to the play area to provide a wildlife habitat, cutting back of brambles and hawthorn to the side of the Bridleway and management of the meadow area to encourage wildlife.

M25 Widening Project

The construction work at South Mimms has begun and preparations are under way for an environmental bund on land between the M25 and St Albans Road. The site is currently being prepared for the process of importing and distributing material excavated from the motorway. Mounds of top soil and sub soil are being created around the field. These mounds will be redistributed over the new landform towards the end of the bund construction process. Wheel washing facilities have been installed for lorries and water sweepers are cleaning the St Albans Road.

Footpaths 27 and 31 will be closed across the field while the bund is being built and will be reinstated under guidance from Hertfordshire County Council Rights of Way department.

The next meeting of the Parish Council will be on Thursday 7th April at 7.30pm in the Village Hall. All residents are welcome to attend.
